
This document outlines the instructions for using Flex:tracker in Unitron TrueFit™ software.

Assigning hearing instruments


1. Detect your hearing instruments the way you normally would in Unitron TrueFit software.




2. When Unitron TrueFit software detects hearing instruments, the software will check if they are Flex:trial™ devices. If they are, and it is the first time that Unitron TrueFit software has detected these trial devices, you will be asked if you want to track the Flex:trial devices using Flex:tracker.




3. After the session is saved, you will be asked if you want to assign the Flex:trial devices to the current client.



4. Unitron TrueFit software will also prompt you to specify an appointment date, unless you have selected not to in the preferences.



5. Log into Flex:tracker.



To log into Flex:tracker without TrueFit: Open a browser

Enter https://www.unitronflextracker.com/ Log in with same account information used in TrueFit. The first time you visit the Flex:tracker site, you will be prompted to select a region.

6. After the Flex:trial devices are assigned, the status of the Flex:trial devices will change to Assigned in the Status Board of Flex:tracker.



 Details about the assignment will be available on the right hand side of the Status Board. If you wish to change assignment details, press the Edit button.




8. The Edit Assignment Details screen allows you to change details of the Assignment if desired. Comments can also be entered.



2. Returning Flex:trial devices

 Log into Flex:tracker. You can access the Flex:tracker website by using the menu item shown here.



2. View the Status Board and select the Flex:trial device to be returned. You can also use the search box to find the patient by last name.



3. Select the Flex:trial device to be returned and click the Return button.



4. Confirm the return.



Reserving Flex:trial devices with Flex:tracker

1. To reserve a Flex:trial device with Flex:tracker, first select an available Flex:trial device.



2. Select the Reserve button for that device.



3. Enter the details of the reservation.



4. Cancelling a reservation with Flex:tracker

1. To cancel a reservation for a Flex:trial device with Flex:tracker, first select a reserved device.



Select the Cancel Reservation button for that device.



How Unitron TrueFit software works with reserved Flex:trial devices

 When fitting a Flex:trial device that has been reserved in Flex:tracker, Unitron TrueFit software will warn you that the device has been reserved and give you the option to continue or cancel (in order to select another device that isn't reserved).




6. Removing a Flex:trial device from Flex:tracker

1. To remove a Flex:trial device from Flex:tracker select the device and press the Delete button.



2. Confirm the deletion.
